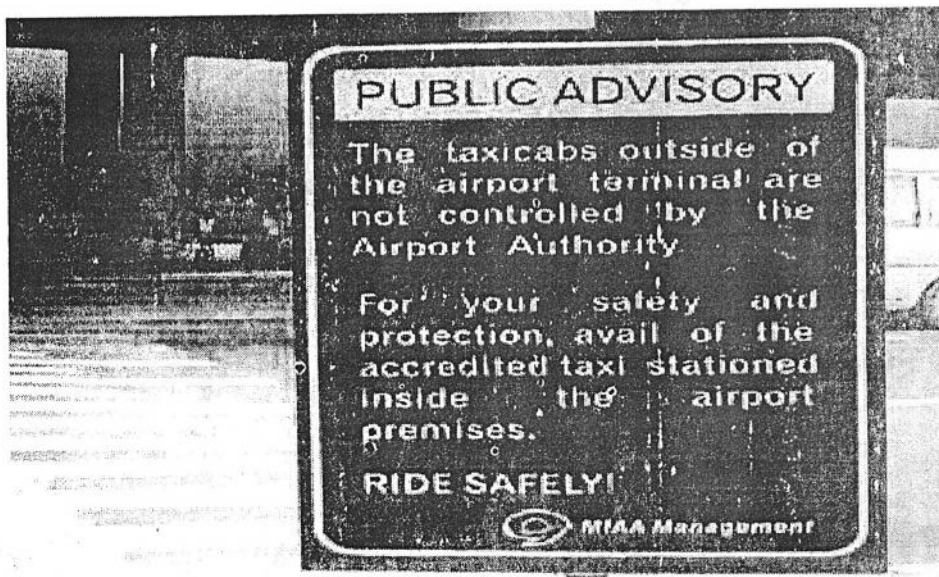

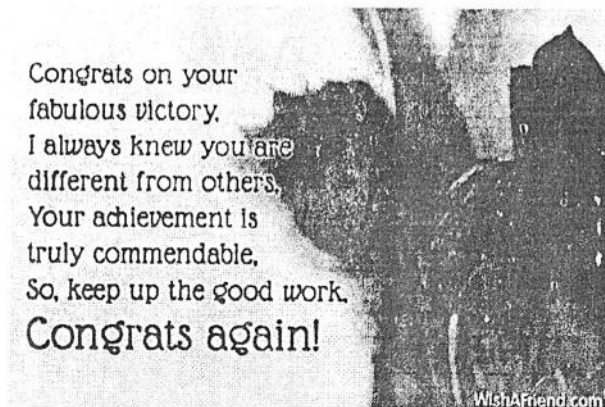

### **Jack Dorsey**

Jack Dorsey is an American web developer and businessman widely known as a co-founder and co-creator of Twitter, and as the founder and CEO of Square, a mobile payments company. In 2008, he was named to the MIT *Technology Review* TR35 as one of the top 35 innovators in the world under the age of 35. For 2012, *The Wall Street Journal* gave him the "Innovator of the Year Award" for technology.

Dorsey was born in St. Louis, Missouri, on November 19, 1976. He is the son of Marcia (Smith) and Tim Dorsey. He is of part Italian descent. His father worked for a company that developed mass spectrometers and his mother was a homemaker. He was raised in Catholic, and his uncle is a Catholic priest in Cincinnati. He went to Catholic high school, at Bishop DuBourg High School.

By the age of thirteen, Dorsey had become interested in dispatch routing. Some of the open source software he created in the area of dispatch logistics is still used in shipping business. This software is also used by many taxi cab companies. Dorsey attended the Missouri University of Science and Technology before subsequently transferring to New York University, where he became involved in web development as a college student, founding the Twitter social networking site in 2006. Since that time, Dorsey has served as CEO, chairman of the board, and executive chairman of Twitter. He also launched the successful online payment platform Square in 2010.

### **Beaucarnea recurvata**

***Beaucarnea recurvata*** (elephant's foot, ponytail palm) is a species of plant in the family Asparagaceae, native to the states of Tamaulipas, Veracruz and San Luis Potosí in eastern Mexico. Despite its common name, it is not closely related to the true palms (Arecaceae).

It was discovered in Mexico by a Frenchman in 1870, becoming popular in Europe and worldwide as an ornamental plant. *Beaucarnea recurvata* is best known for its response to sound waves, growing faster in loud populated areas. There are 350 year-old *Beaucarneas* registered in Mexico.

It is an evergreen perennial growing to 15 feet 6 inches (4.72 m) with a noticeable expanded caudex, for the purpose of storing water inside. The single palm-like stem produces terminal tufts of strap-shaped, recurved leathery leaves, sometimes hair lock-shaped in the ends, and with occasional panicles of small white flowers once the plant reaches over 10 years of age.

*Beaucarnea recurvata* is often grown as a houseplant or outdoor plant in temperate climate gardens. It is hardy to  $-5^{\circ}\text{C}$  ( $23^{\circ}\text{F}$ ), and grows in full sun to light shade. It needs a proper soil mix to drain when watered, and must never be over-watered or muddled, as this will foster pests like the mealybug and cochineal insect. It cannot resist cold temperatures so it must be an indoor plant in countries with strong winters. When repotted it must keep all its roots. To maintain its original shape, the ends of its leaves should not be snipped. It is very slow-growing and drought-tolerant. It has gained the Royal Horticultural Society's Award of Garden Merit.

### Dawet Ayu Banjarnegara

#### Ingredients.

##### Dawet:

- 150 grams hunkwe flour (Sago Palm flour)
- 600 ml of water
- 2 pieces of pandan leaves for flavouring coconut milk
- 100 ml of water and suji pandan leaves.
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 500 grams of brown sugar, sliced
- some ice cubes

##### Tool:

- Filter or dawet mold (You can make your own, prepare a piece of cloth and make the holes using nail or something)
- The basin
- Wooden spoon for stirring batter

##### Brown Sugar Sauce:

- 500 gr brown sugar / palm sugar (if it is less sweet Sugar can be added)- sliced and boiled

##### Coconut Milk gravy:

- 1000 ml of coconut milk
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 2 pieces pandan leaves

#### How to Make Dawet Ayu Banjarnegara:

1. Mix Hunkwe flour, suji pandan leaves water, and salt, stir until hunkwie flour dissolves.
2. Cook the flour mixture, stirring constantly until the mixture coagulates and mature.
3. Prepare a basin of boiled water and mold cendol above covering the basin. Pour a dawet batter little by little, press dawet batter slowly, until the batter out into the basin. Do it until the batter runs out.
4. Boil sugar and water until sugar dissolves, remove from heat and strain. Set aside.
5. Boil the coconut milk, salt and pandan leaves over low heat, stirring constantly until boiling. Remove from heat and let it cool.
6. Pour brown sugar sauce in a cup sufficiently, add dawet, coconut milk gravy, and some ice cubes.
7. Serve it with some slices of jackfruit for more flavors.

#### **BPJS (A Social Security Provider)**

BPJS is a public agency established to implement the social security program. The health insurance prepared through BPJS is in the form health protection for participants to get health care benefits and protection to meet the basic needs of health care. It is provided to every person who has paid fees or whose contributions are paid by the government.

All Indonesian citizens must become the participants of health insurance managed by BPJS. BPJS participants are divided into two groups, i.e.:

1. Contribution Assistance Recipients (PBI) including the poor, near poor and totally disabled persons as stipulated in SJSN Law whose contributions are paid by the government.
